MS. HOYLE: Good evening. My name is Jennifer Hoyle. I'm the Director of Strategic Management and Partnerships for the Chicago Housing Authority. I would like to welcome you to the public comment hearing on the draft TSP and Lease for the Concord at Sheridan, a mixed income rental housing development at 6418 North Sheridan. The purpose of the hearing is to collect comments on the draft TSP and Lease for the Concord at Sheridan before the comments are submitted to the Board of Commissioners for approval.

In addition to voicing your comments here tonight, residents and members of the public can submit written comments to CHA throughout the comment period, which began on March 17th and ends on April 17th. Copies of the documents are available on the CHA's website at www.thecha.org. We also have copies of these documents available here today.

I'm going to begin the meeting by making several introductions. Michael Albert is our sign language interpreter. He is seated right over here. Beatrice Gartler is our Spanish language interpreter. Rachel Smith is the court reporter,

and she will transcribe everything that is said during the hearing. She's seated up front right here.

The following members of the development team are also present. Thomas Worthy is the CHA's development manager for the project. Virginia Hayes from The Nightingale Group is one of our development partners here tonight, and Janae Hayes Muhammad is here on behalf of Habitat.

Before we move into the public comment section, Virginia Hayes from The Nightingale Group will provide a brief overview of the project.

MS. HAYES: Thank you. Good evening. So the Concord at Sheridan is a 111-unit residential building. It sits on top of approximately 30,000 square feet of retail, which is now part of the project. The project has 65 CHA RAD units and 46-market rate units. All units are one and two bedrooms. The project includes one and two bedrooms nicely equipped with washers and dryers.

There is a common area including a fitness room, computer room, office space and the property will also have a full-time service coordinator through the year. The project is



1	anticipated to close and start construction by the
2	fall of this year, with occupancy beginning in fall
3	of 2018.
4	MS. HOYLE: Thank you. At this time I don't
5	believe there are any members of the public here who
