Levy House: Resident Selection

- Senior housing for households age 62+
- Residents earning up to 80% of Area Median Income
- Initiate waitlist opening process upon acquisition of building by POAH
- Complete preliminary application
- Invitation to complete full application based on waitlist number & bedroom size availability
- Full applications reviewed and vetted through the tenant selection process
